

How to strip the outer sheath of a single-mode armored optical fiber



Article Overview

Use a sheath knife to score the outer sheath, expose the ripcords, and pull them to safely remove the armor and jacket without damaging the fiber.

Step-by-Step Procedure

1. Prepare the Cable and Tools

- Wear safety gloves and glasses to protect against sharp tools and fiber shards .
- Gather a sheath knife, side cutters, and needle-nose pliers .

• Identify the section of the cable where the sheath will be removed and mark the length to expose the ripcords .

2. Score the Outer Sheath

• Use the sheath knife to ring the circumference of the outer sheath about 3-5 inches from the cable end .

• Apply enough pressure to cut through the sheath and score the underlying armor without cutting the fiber inside .

• Flex the scored section to crack the sheath and armor, then slide the separated section off the cable end .

3. Expose and Use Ripcords

• Locate the ripcords under the sheath.

• Nick the armor at the points where the ripcords disappear under the sheath using side cutters or a knife to create a starting point .
