

How to wire the blue cable tray in the distribution box

Wiring a blue cable tray in a distribution box involves proper routing, securing, grounding, and segregation of cables to ensure safety and compliance with electrical standards.

Step 1: Plan and Inspect

Before wiring, confirm the layout and dimensions of the distribution box and cable tray. Inspect the tray for damage and ensure it matches the approved design and load requirements (). Identify the circuits and label the tray according to feeder names or branch numbers to maintain organization ().

Step 2: Mount the Cable Tray

Secure the blue cable tray using appropriate brackets and clamps, ensuring supports are spaced correctly (typically 1.5–3 meters apart depending on tray type and load) (). Align the tray straight and level to prevent sagging and allow easy cable installation.

Step 3: Route the Cables

- Segregate cables by type (power, control, data) to reduce electromagnetic interference ().
- Lay the cables neatly inside the tray, avoiding sharp bends and excessive tension.
- Ensure the tray is not overfilled; calculate cable fill according to NEC 392.22 or local standards to prevent overheating ().
