

Install sockets in the secondary distribution box



Article Overview

To install sockets from a secondary distribution box, you must run correctly rated cables from the secondary consumer unit, protect each circuit with RCBOs or RCDs, and ensure proper earthing and compliance with wiring regulations.

Planning and Safety

Before installation, determine the total load for the sockets and any connected devices. The secondary consumer unit should be fed from the main consumer unit with a supply cable rated for the expected load and installation method, ensuring it can handle the combined amperage of all circuits . Always isolate the main supply before starting work and use a socket tester to confirm circuits are dead . Compliance with local building regulations (e.g., Part P in the UK) is mandatory, and installations should ideally be performed by a qualified electrician .

Wiring the Sockets

- **Circuit Protection:** Each socket circuit should be protected by an RCBO or RCD in the secondary consumer unit to prevent electric shock and isolate faults .
- **Cable Selection:** Use cables rated for the load and length of the run. For example, a 16A socket circuit may require 2.5 mm² twin and earth cable, while lighting circuits may use 1.5 mm² .
