Health and Radiation Safety

Fiber optic cables transmit data using light signals, which are non-ionizing and do not emit harmful radiation. Unlike wireless technologies, they do not produce electromagnetic fields, making them safe for your home environment and health . The light used in fiber optics is typically in the infrared range, which cannot penetrate deeply into the body and does not damage tissues . Public health organizations consider fiber optic internet safer than some wireless alternatives due to these properties .

Physical Hazards

While the cables themselves are safe, installation requires caution. Fiber strands are delicate and can break, producing tiny glass shards that may cause injury if handled improperly . Additionally, exposure to the laser light from active fiber ends can damage eyes if viewed directly, though this risk is minimal when cables are properly terminated and enclosed . Following proper safety protocols and using protective equipment during installation mitigates these risks.
