

Keep electric heating equipment at a distance from the distribution box



Overview

There should be at least 3 feet of clearance in front of and to the side of electrical equipment. Assure electrical disconnects are correctly marked and correspond to the equipment's energy control procedures for lockout activities. Is distance satisfactory to protect power distribution boxes (breaker boxes, disconnects ranging from anywhere from 50 volts to 440 volts) from damage in active warehouses with stacked material, fork truck traffic, and pedestrian traffic; or does there need to be a protective barrier?

If distance. Electrical clearances set the minimum safe distances for panels, overhead lines, pools, and buried wiring — and ignoring them has real consequences. Safety of equipment shall be determined using the following considerations: Suitability for installation and use in conformity with the provisions of this subpart; Note to. Circuit breaker identification listings need to be near or on the inside door of panel boxes that house circuit breakers. This chart guides how close workers can safely get to energized equipment based on system voltages and other factors. Limited Approach Boundary - The Limited Approach Boundary (LAB) is identified as the “distance from an exposed energized electrical conductor or circuit part within which a shock hazard exists”. Best practice if for any unqualified person to stay 42” (3' 6”) or more away from the hazard.
