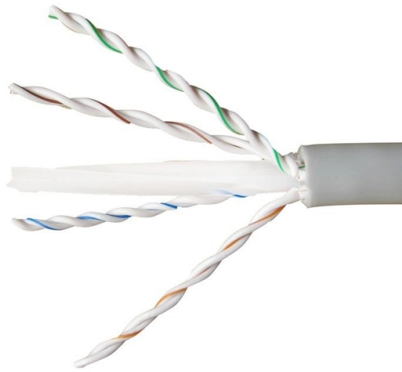


MPO connector male pin



Article Overview

An MPO male connector features two metal guide pins that ensure precise fiber alignment and must always mate with a female (no-pin) MPO connector.

Structure and Function

An MPO male connector is distinguished by two metal guide pins extending from its MT ferrule. These pins are critical for mechanical alignment, ensuring that multiple fibers in the connector line up accurately with the corresponding fibers in the mating connector. The pins prevent misalignment that could cause signal loss or damage to the fiber ends.

Usage Rules

- Male connectors must always mate with female connectors (which have alignment holes) to avoid pin-to-pin contact that can permanently damage the connectors.
- Never connect two male MPO connectors directly, as the pins will collide and cause irreversible damage.
- Male connectors are commonly used in trunk cables and backbone cabling, providing a fixed alignment reference for cassettes, modules, or transceivers.

Field Identification

- Male MPO connectors have visible metal pins on the ferrule.
- Female MPO connectors have pinholes without pins.
