Vertical bends in cable trays can be achieved using proper cutting, bending techniques, or elbow fittings, allowing smooth upward or downward transitions without compromising cable integrity.

Methods for Vertical Bends

1. Wire Mesh Cable Trays Wire mesh trays are highly flexible and allow on-site vertical bends without additional fittings. To create a vertical bend:

- Identify the section where the bend is required.
- Cut only the necessary wires at the bend location, avoiding complete wire removal to maintain structural integrity .
- Gradually bend the tray upward or downward to the desired angle, typically 45° or 90°, ensuring smooth curvature to prevent cable damage .

• For complex angles, multiple small bends can be combined to form a smooth vertical transition . 2. Using Elbow Fittings For solid or rigid trays, vertical bends are often achieved with elbow joints:

- Insert the elbow joint inside the tray at the desired location.
- Secure it using screws or the provided attachment set .

• Elbow joints can accommodate a range of angles, typically from -90° to +90°, allowing both upward and downward transitions . 3. Tee and Custom Configurations
