IPC-A-640, officially titled “Acceptance Requirements for Optical Fiber, Optical Cable, and Hybrid Wiring Harness Assemblies,” provides acceptance criteria for cable and wire harness assemblies that incorporate optical fiber technology. While most engineers are familiar with IPC-A-620 for copper wire harnesses, IPC-A-640 addresses the unique inspection and acceptance challenges that fiber. Many other groups also have cable assembly standards, including some that focus on specific industries or applications.
