The standard covers the materials, construction, and performance of these cables, as well as the applicable test. The Insulated Cable Engineers Association, Inc. (ICEA) standards and guideline publications, of which the document contained herein is one, are developed through a voluntary consensus standards development process. The first edition of this Standard was approved by ICEA on June 5, 2003. However, it is not always easy to find out what has been covered, and where it can be found.
