They are highly valued for their small size, immunity to electromagnetic interference, resistance to high temperatures, and ability to operate in hazardous environments. These features make them suitable for applications in North Macedonia's industrial, energy, and infrastructure sectors.

Types and Functions

- **Intrinsic Fiber Optic Sensors**
 - The fiber itself acts as the sensing element, detecting changes in strain, temperature, pressure, or vibration by modulating light properties such as intensity, phase, wavelength, or polarization.
 - Functions include structural health monitoring of bridges, buildings, and pipelines, providing real-time data on stress or deformation.
- **Extrinsic Fiber Optic Sensors**
 - The fiber transmits light to and from an external sensing element.
