Overview

This tutorial gives an introduction to the HY-M154 / 817 optocoupler module. Moreover, a simple application is programmed that shows how to wire and how to program an Arduino when working with the module. 1x2 couplers are manufactured using the same process as our 2x2 fiber optic couplers, except the second input port is internally terminated using a proprietary method that minimizes back.
