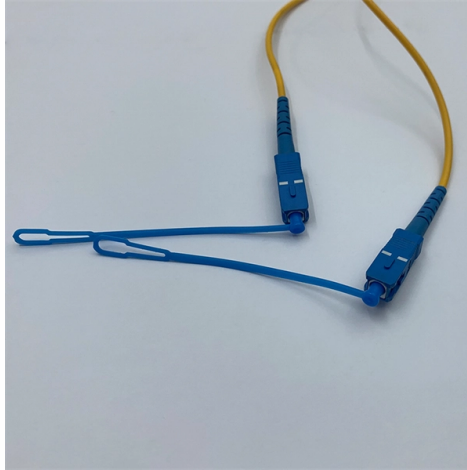


Optical Module MOP

An optical module is a key component in fiber optic communication systems, converting electrical signals to optical signals and vice versa, often using MPO/MTP connectors for high-density multi-fiber connections.

What is an Optical Module?

An optical module operates at the physical layer of the OSI model and is essential for high-speed optical communication. Its primary function is optoelectronic conversion, transforming electrical signals into optical signals for transmission and converting received optical signals back into electrical signals. Typical components include:

- TOSA (Transmitter Optical Sub-Assembly): Contains a laser diode or LED to emit light, an optical interface, a monitoring photodiode, and a housing. Laser diodes are preferred for high-speed, long-distance transmission due to higher output power and efficiency.
- ROSA (Receiver Optical Sub-Assembly): Converts incoming optical signals into electrical signals using photodetectors.
- Driver and control circuits: Manage signal modulation, automatic optical power control (APC), and overall module operation.
- Housing and interface: Provides mechanical protection and standardized electrical/optical connections. Optical modules are used in SFP, SFP+, XFP, CFP, and other pluggable transceivers, supporting data rates from 100 Gbps to 400 Gbps and beyond, suitable for 5G, data centers, and high-bandwidth networks.
