Fibers are classified as single-mode (propagating only the fundamental mode) or multimode (propagating multiple modes), with multimode fibers further divided into step-index and graded-index types, each offering different performance characteristics. The choice of fiber type depends on the intended application, distance, and bandwidth requirements.

Cable Structure and Protection

To protect the delicate fibers, they are incorporated into a cable structure that includes:

- Buffer layers: Provide mechanical protection and isolate fibers from stress.
- Strength members: Materials like aramid yarn or steel rods that prevent stretching and maintain structural integrity.
