

Outdoor cable trays require supports

Outdoor cable trays must be properly supported based on span, load, material, and environmental conditions to ensure safety, durability, and code compliance.

Support Span and Load Considerations

The distance between supports is critical and must be determined according to the manufacturer's load capacity charts and the total anticipated weight of the cables, including future expansion . Overloading or exceeding the recommended span can lead to sagging, cable damage, or structural failure. Typical support spans vary by tray type: ladder trays generally allow longer spans than solid-bottom or ventilated trough trays due to their structural design .

Support Methods

Common support methods for outdoor installations include:

- Trapeze hangers: Suspended from ceilings or overhead structures, suitable for long horizontal runs.
- Cantilever wall brackets: Mounted directly to walls for vertical or horizontal runs along building exteriors.
- Direct supports from structural steel or poles: Often used in industrial or utility outdoor settings . The choice of support method depends on the building structure, tray route, and environmental exposure.

Material Selection and Environmental Protection
