Understanding Parallel Wiring

In household electrical systems, parallel wiring means that each appliance or branch circuit is connected independently to the main supply, allowing each circuit to operate separately. This is the standard method for domestic wiring, ensuring that turning off one circuit does not affect others and that current is distributed safely across all circuits . Important Note: Using jumpers—where one wire feeds multiple breakers in series—is prohibited by national standards because it can overload wires and create fire hazards . Each circuit breaker should receive its own direct connection from the main bus bar.

Steps for Safe Parallel Installation

- **Select the Right Distribution Box:** Choose a box with sufficient capacity for all branch circuits, proper IP/NEMA rating, and durable material (steel or high-quality plastic) for protection against dust and moisture .
- **Wire Sizing:** Use wires with appropriate gauge to handle the expected load. Copper is preferred for its high conductivity and durability. Voltage drop should be considered for long runs, as resistance increases with length and decreases with wire diameter .
