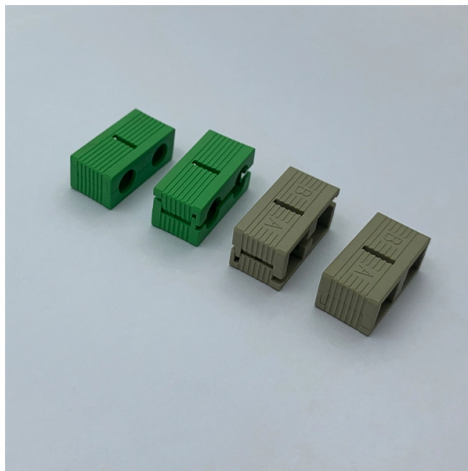

This allows operators to detect underperforming strings, potential faults, and environmental impacts on the system.

- **Real-Time String Monitoring:** Each string's current, voltage, and temperature are continuously measured, enabling immediate detection of anomalies or power losses.
- **Arc Fault Detection:** Advanced systems integrate AFCI (Arc Fault Circuit Interrupter) technology, identifying dangerous DC arc faults at the module level within milliseconds, significantly reducing fire risks.
- **Data Communication:** Monitoring systems support RS485 Modbus-RTU and industrial wireless protocols, allowing seamless integration with both legacy and modern PV systems.
- **Retrofitting Capability:** Modular designs allow existing combiner boxes to be upgraded without full replacement, minimizing downtime and installation costs.
