Primary Equipment for Relay Commissioning

1. Secondary Injection Test Sets

- Used to inject controlled currents and voltages into the relay secondary circuits to verify relay operation without energizing the primary system .

- Examples include portable relay test sets capable of simulating overcurrent, differential, and distance protection conditions. 2. Primary Injection Test Equipment

- Supplies actual high currents and voltages to the relay through the primary circuit to test the complete protection scheme under realistic conditions .

- Essential for verifying CT/VT ratios, relay tripping, and stability under fault conditions. 3. Current and Voltage Measurement Instruments

- Moving coil ammeters, digital multimeters, and clamp meters for checking CT/VT outputs, polarity, and secondary currents .

- Used for polarity checks, ratio verification, and magnetizing curve tests of current transformers. 4. Variable Transformers and Power Supplies

- AC/DC variable transformers to provide adjustable voltage and current for testing relay thresholds and trip points .
