Relay protection for transformer line groups ensures safe operation by detecting faults and initiating circuit breaker trips to prevent transformer damage and maintain system stability.

Overview of Transformer Relay Protection

Transformer protection involves using protective relays to monitor electrical parameters such as current, voltage, and power, and to detect abnormal conditions like short circuits, overloads, or phase imbalances. Protective relays are connected to current transformers (CTs) and voltage transformers (VTs), which provide scaled signals for relay operation. When a fault occurs, the relay sends a trip signal to the circuit breaker, isolating the transformer or line to prevent damage and maintain system reliability .

Common Protection Schemes

- Differential Protection (87T)
 - Protects the transformer windings by comparing currents entering and leaving the transformer.
 - Sensitive to internal faults and fast-acting, minimizing damage.
 - Often applied to two-winding and generator-transformer blocks .
- Overcurrent Protection (50/51)
 - Detects excessive current due to short circuits or overloads.
 - Can be phase or ground overcurrent depending on the fault type.
 - Provides backup protection if differential protection fails .
