

Requirements for bridging connections of secondary distribution box doors

However, the newly released industry standard has revised this practice, with the specific requirements as follows: The metal cabinet door and the cabinet body must be electrically connected by braided soft copper wire. Yellow-green insulated wires should be used for. Many distribution box doors still use braided soft copper wire for bridging, and this practice is often subject to rectification.
