

Requirements for electrical distribution boxes in workshops

Workshop distribution boxes must be robust, properly rated, safely installed, and compliant with electrical standards to handle heavy industrial loads.

Enclosure and Material Requirements

Distribution boxes in workshops should be constructed from heavy-duty materials such as cold-rolled steel for maximum structural rigidity, fire resistance, and durability, or high-grade, UV-resistant, halogen-free plastics for corrosive or specialized environments . The enclosure must protect internal components from dust, moisture, chemical splashes, and physical impacts. For workshops with sawdust, moisture, or chemical exposure, an IP65 rating is recommended to ensure complete isolation from environmental hazards .

Electrical Load and Configuration

Workshops often require three-phase 400V distribution boxes to power industrial machinery, compressors, and heavy-duty equipment without voltage drops . The box should be sized according to the expected load, with proper voltage and current ratings to prevent overheating and ensure reliable operation . Each circuit should have its own MCB, RCCB, or RCBO for overload and fault protection .

Installation Requirements

- **Placement:** Install in a dry, well-ventilated, and accessible area, typically 1.5–1.8 meters above the floor for easy operation and inspection . Avoid humid or corrosive locations.
