

# Sealing at the base of the vertical shaft cable tray



## Article Overview

The base of a vertical shaft cable tray should be tightly sealed using fire-resistant materials, waterstops, and proper firestop systems to prevent fire, smoke, and water penetration.

### Fireproof Sealing Requirements

When a vertical cable tray passes through a shaft, the opening at the base must be sealed with firestopping materials in accordance with design and code requirements. Openings should be free of visible cracks or voids, and for large gaps, a fire-resistant backing plate should be installed before sealing. Firestop materials can include fire-rated boards, mineral wool, firestop packs, or firestop mastic, and gaps between the materials and cables should not exceed 1 cm<sup>2</sup>, with packing thickness of at least 24 cm.

### Waterstop and Threshold Considerations

At floor level or slab penetrations, a waterstop of at least 50 mm in height is recommended to prevent water ingress into the shaft. The base of the shaft should have a threshold to support the tray and provide a secure surface for sealing. Proper alignment and positioning of the tray facilitate both installation and maintenance.

### Firestop Systems and Materials

Several tested firestop systems are suitable for cable tray penetrations:

- Panel seals: Protect both single and bundled cables, including optical fibers, and their supporting structures, with fire resistance up to 120 minutes.
