

Standard Requirements for Cutting Mesh Cable Trays



Article Overview

Cutting mesh cable trays must comply with IEC 61537, NEMA VE 1, and manufacturer guidelines to ensure mechanical integrity, electrical continuity, and safety.

Material and Mechanical Considerations

Mesh cable trays are typically made from high-strength steel, stainless steel, or aluminum, with corrosion-resistant coatings or finishes depending on the environment . When cutting, it is essential to maintain the structural integrity of the tray, avoiding deformation of the mesh or weakening of load-bearing sections. Sharp edges should be deburred to prevent cable damage and ensure safe handling . The tray must continue to meet load and span requirements as specified in IEC 61537 and NEMA VE 1 after any modification .

Electrical and Safety Requirements

Mesh cable trays often serve as part of the grounding or bonding system. Cutting should not compromise electrical continuity; any joints or cut ends must maintain a resistance of less than 0.1 ohms across connections if used for grounding . Additionally, trays must retain fire resistance and ventilation properties, ensuring proper cable cooling and preventing overheating .

- Use appropriate cutting tools such as metal shears, angle grinders, or band saws designed for the tray material.
