Key Standards and Guidelines

It covers planning, installation, testing, and maintenance of fiber optic networks, including both aerial and underground deployments . The standard emphasizes proper site surveys, route planning, and adherence to local regulations and permits before construction begins . NOANET Fiber Optic Construction Standards detail specific construction requirements, including:

- **Utility Pole Clearances:** Minimum 18 feet above traveled roads and 40 inches from energized conductors .
- **Attachment Guidelines:** Only attach to existing anchors with permission; avoid auxiliary eye attachments or guying to communication anchors .
- **Grounding and Bonding:** Proper grounding of fiber optic cables and associated hardware is required to prevent electrical hazards .
- **Riser and Climbing Space Requirements:** Standards for vertical installations and safe climbing clearances on poles .
