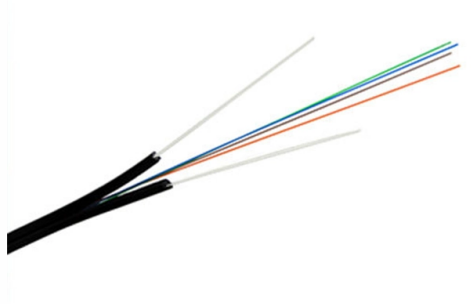


Standard for Fan Distribution Box Panels



Article Overview

Fan distribution box panels must comply with IEC 61439, IEC 60364, and BS 7671 standards, ensuring safe, accessible, and properly protected electrical distribution.

Key Standards

IEC 61439 defines requirements for low-voltage switchgear and controlgear assemblies, including distribution panels, covering design, construction, testing, and safety features. It ensures panels are robust, electrically safe, and suitable for their intended environment . IEC 60364 provides guidelines for low-voltage electrical installations, including proper placement, accessibility, and environmental considerations for distribution boards . BS 7671 (UK Wiring Regulations) aligns with IEC standards and specifies installation requirements such as mounting height, clearances, protection against water and dust, and safe access for maintenance .

Installation and Safety Requirements

- **Accessibility:** Panels must be readily accessible for operation, inspection, and maintenance. Recommended mounting height for residential units is 1-1.8 meters, with 1.3 meters suggested for elderly or handicapped users .
- **Clearances:** Adequate working space around the panel is required to ensure safe access to live components .
- **Protection Ratings:** Panels should have appropriate IP ratings (e.g., IP54 for industrial environments) to protect against dust and water ingress .
- **Switchgear and Covers:** Live parts must be insulated or covered, and metallic panels require double insulation or protective covers .
