

Switches that receive fiber optic cables

Switches can be connected to fiber optic cables using SFP or SFP+ modules, with single-mode or multimode fiber depending on distance and network requirements.

Types of Switches and Ports

Modern network switches often include SFP (Small Form-factor Pluggable) or SFP+ ports, which allow fiber optic connections in addition to traditional copper (RJ45) ports . Some switches feature combo ports, where a single logical port can use either copper or fiber, but not both simultaneously . SFP ports typically support speeds up to 1 Gbps, while SFP+ ports support 10 Gbps, and QSFP modules can handle even higher bandwidths .

Fiber Types and Modules

- Multimode fiber: Suitable for short distances (typically under 1000 feet), often using 850nm wavelength .
- Single-mode fiber: Used for long-distance connections (several kilometers), typically using 1310nm or 1550nm wavelength .
- SFP/SFP+ modules: Transceivers that convert electrical signals from the switch into optical signals for the fiber. Ensure the module matches the fiber type and switch port speed .

Connecting Switches

- Insert SFP/SFP+ modules into the switch ports. These modules are usually hot-swappable .
