Buzzing in cable trays is usually caused by electromagnetic induction and resonance from energized cables interacting with metal structures.

Causes of Buzzing

- **Electromagnetic Induction and Eddy Currents:** When cables, especially three-phase metal-armored cables, are energized, they generate alternating magnetic fields. These fields induce eddy currents in the steel armor or nearby metal structures, producing vibrations that manifest as a buzzing sound. Higher currents intensify this effect, which can also lead to heating and reduced current-carrying capacity, potentially creating a fire hazard if severe .
- **Cable Layout and Proximity to Metal:** The way cables are arranged in trays or near metal supports can amplify resonance. Metal cable trays themselves can become magnetized by the current, contributing to the audible hum. Improper spacing or tight bundling of cables increases the likelihood of buzzing .
- **Harmonics and Electrical Noise:** In some cases, harmonics in the electrical supply or added components like ferrite cores can create additional buzzing. If the ferrite cores are overloaded or the current exceeds their design, they may vibrate and produce noise even at standard 50 Hz mains frequency .
