Common Causes of Overheating

- **Circuit Overload:** When too many high-power devices operate on the same circuit, the current exceeds the designed capacity, generating heat and potentially tripping breakers or blowing fuses .
- **Loose or Damaged Connections:** Worn or improperly tightened terminals increase resistance, causing localized heating inside the box .
- **Aging or Outdated Components:** Old fuses, circuit breakers, or aluminum wiring can degrade over time, leading to oxidation, poor contact, and heat buildup .
- **Poor Ventilation:** Distribution boxes in enclosed or poorly ventilated spaces trap heat, exacerbating overheating even under moderate loads .

Warning Signs

- Warm or hot panel to the touch
- Flickering lights or frequent breaker trips
- Discoloration around fuses or breakers
- Burning smell or buzzing sounds
