Fiber optic pigtails are typically jacketed with PVC or LSZH, not PEI.

A fiber optic pigtail is a short optical fiber cable with a factory-installed connector on one end (such as SC, LC, ST, or FC) and a bare fiber on the other end for splicing to a main fiber optic cable . Pigtails are used to simplify field terminations, reduce connection loss, and provide reliable splicing in optical distribution frames, fiber termination boxes, and outdoor enclosures . Jacket Materials:

- Most fiber optic pigtails use PVC (Polyvinyl Chloride) or LSZH (Low Smoke Zero Halogen) jackets .
- The jacket protects the fiber during handling and splicing but is usually thin (around 0.9 mm diameter) because the pigtail is intended to be spliced and stored in a splice tray .
- PEI (Polyetherimide) is not commonly used for standard fiber optic pigtails; it is more typical in high-temperature or specialized industrial applications, not in standard telecom or data center pigtails. Fiber Types and Applications:
- Single-mode pigtails (G652D, G657A1, G657A2) are used for long-distance, high-bandwidth applications.
- Multimode pigtails (OM1, OM2, OM3, OM4) are used for shorter distances and high-speed LAN or data center connections .
