(1) Power distribution from the primary main distribution board (distribution cabinet) to secondary distribution boards can be branched; that is, one main distribution board may supply power via multiple branch circuits to several secondary distribution boards. (2) Similarly, power distribution. The outgoing line from the low-voltage end of the transformer is 0.4kV to the distribution cabinet (primary distribution cabinet), then the outgoing line is led to the distribution box (secondary distribution box) in each building, and finally the outgoing line is led to the distribution cabinet. In a newly constructed residential area, a 10kV power line is introduced into the substation. These boxes feature bottom entry and exit cables, front-opening doors, and main busbars connected with copper strips for optimal contact.
