

The wires in the distribution box are one size smaller



Article Overview

If the wires in a distribution box are one size smaller, the box may still be compliant if the total conductor volume is recalculated according to NEC box-fill rules.

Implications of Smaller Wires

Using wires that are one size smaller than originally planned affects the conductor volume allowance in the box. NEC Table 314.16(B) assigns a specific cubic-inch volume to each conductor size. Smaller wires occupy less space, which can reduce the total required box volume, potentially allowing the existing box to remain compliant. However, the current-carrying capacity of the smaller wires must also be considered, as undersized wires can overheat if the circuit load exceeds their rating.

Box Fill Considerations

To ensure safety and code compliance:

- Count all conductors: Each wire entering the box and terminating or spliced inside counts as one conductor. Ground wires count as a single conductor allowance for up to four wires, with additional grounds requiring a 1/2 allowance each.
- Include device yokes and clamps: Each device yoke counts as two conductor allowances, and internal clamps count as one.
- Calculate total volume: Multiply the number of conductor equivalents by the cubic-inch allowance for the largest conductor in the box. If multiple wire sizes are present, the largest conductor determines the allowance for clamps and grounds.
