Additionally, loose cables and wires create trip and fall hazards, which are common on construction sites lacking organized electrical setups .

Regulatory and Compliance Implications

Temporary electrical installations are governed by the National Electrical Code (NEC) and OSHA standards in the U.S. . NEC Article 590 specifies that all temporary wiring and equipment must be rated for site conditions, and improper installations can result in fines, work stoppages, or shutdowns . OSHA mandates that electrical hazards be mitigated to protect workers, and failure to provide a compliant distribution system constitutes a violation of workplace safety regulations . Local building codes may also impose additional requirements for temporary power setups.
