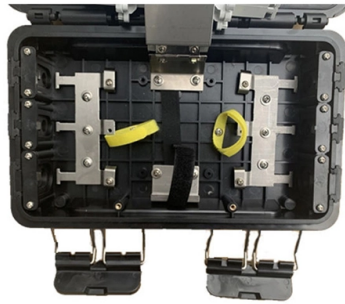


Thickness requirements for cable tray support angle iron



Article Overview

The typical thickness for angle iron supports for cable trays ranges from 3 mm to 6 mm, depending on load, span, and environmental conditions.

Key Considerations

Material Thickness and Load Capacity: The thickness of angle iron supports directly affects the structural stability and load-bearing capacity of the cable tray system. Thicker supports reduce deflection and sagging, especially for heavy cable loads or long spans, while thinner supports may suffice for lighter installations or shorter spans .

Standard Practices: For standard installations, angle iron supports are commonly manufactured with a thickness of 3 mm to 6 mm. The exact choice depends on:

- Tray type and width: Ladder trays carrying heavy power cables may require thicker supports.
- Span length: Longer spans between supports require increased thickness to prevent bending.
- Environmental factors: Corrosive or outdoor environments may necessitate thicker or coated steel to maintain durability .
