

UPS Dual Busbar Connection

A dual-unit dual-busbar UPS configuration provides high reliability and redundancy by connecting two independent UPS systems to separate busbars, ensuring continuous power to critical loads.

Overview of Dual-Bus UPS Systems

A dual-bus system consists of two independent UPS units, typically designated as a master and a slave. Each UPS feeds a separate busbar, allowing critical loads with multiple input terminals to receive power from either UPS. This setup enhances reliability because if one UPS fails or is in bypass mode, the other can continue supplying power without interruption. Optional Static Transfer Switches (STS) can be installed to synchronize the buses and manage load transfer between UPS units.

Busbar Connection

Busbars are the conductive bars that distribute power from the UPS to the load or maintenance bypass cabinet. In a dual-bus configuration:

- Input busbars connect each UPS to its respective bus.
- Neutral and ground busbars ensure proper electrical safety and system stability.
- DC busbars handle the internal DC link connections.
- Bypass busbars allow power to bypass the UPS during maintenance or fault conditions. Installation requires following manufacturer torque specifications (e.g., M8x30 screws torqued to 17.5 Nm) and using insulator parts to prevent short circuits.
