Key Principles for Cable Tray Ventilation

1. Tray Design and Material Selection

- Open or perforated trays allow air to circulate freely around cables, enhancing heat dissipation and preventing thermal buildup .
- Wire mesh (basket) trays are particularly effective for telecommunications and IT infrastructure, as their grid pattern maximizes airflow while supporting smaller cables .

• Materials such as galvanized steel, stainless steel, or aluminum provide durability, corrosion resistance, and improved thermal conduction .

2. Ventilation Ratio and Airflow Optimization

- The ventilation ratio is the percentage of open area relative to the tray's reference area. Industry practice targets $>30\%$ for power cables to ensure adequate cooling .
 - Wider trays with the same open area may reduce airflow velocity, so spacing and perforation placement must be carefully planned .
 - Heat release holes on the sides or bottom of trays further improve air movement and allow heat to escape efficiently .
