In industrial settings, cable trays are often open types, such as ladder or perforated trays, to allow heat dissipation and easy access for maintenance or cable upgrades. The material selection also considers factors like mechanical strength, thermal expansion, chemical exposure, and cost-effectiveness, ensuring safe and long-lasting cable support.
