Copper is preferred for busbars due to its excellent electrical conductivity, thermal efficiency, mechanical strength, and resistance to corrosion. These properties ensure stable current flow, minimize voltage drops, and allow the busbar to handle high currents safely over long periods. Copper busbars also dissipate heat effectively, reducing the risk of overheating in high-load conditions.

- Collect power from the main incoming supply.
