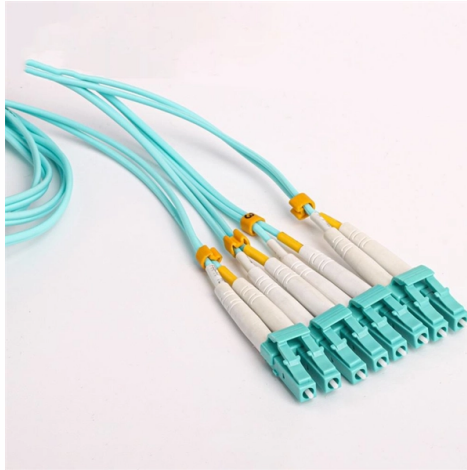


What are the components of an optical fiber connection
