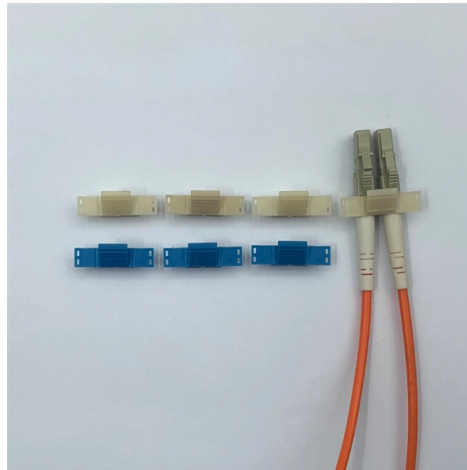


What are the different types of single-mode fiber optic connectors

SC (Subscriber Connector)

The SC connector is a square-shaped, push-pull type connector that uses a ceramic ferrule for precise fiber alignment. It is widely used in FTTH deployments, data centers, and GPON networks where low return loss is critical. SC connectors are suitable for both simplex and duplex applications and are known for their ease of installation and secure snap-in latch mechanism .

LC (Lucent Connector)

The LC connector is a small form-factor connector with a 1.25mm ferrule, making it ideal for high-density applications. It features a push-pull latch similar to an RJ45 plug and is commonly used in data centers and LAN environments. LC connectors support both simplex and duplex configurations and are favored for their compact size and reliable performance .

ST (Straight Tip)

The ST connector is an older design with a bayonet-style twist-lock mechanism. It has a round metal body and a ceramic ferrule for precise fiber alignment. ST connectors are still used in industrial and legacy networks where robust mechanical connections are required. They are compatible with both simplex and duplex setups .
