

What are the uplink and downlink of an optical splitter

An optical splitter distributes downstream signals from the OLT to multiple ONUs and consolidates upstream signals from ONUs back to the OLT, enabling efficient bidirectional communication in PON networks.

Overview of Optical Splitters

An optical splitter is a passive device used in EPON/GPON networks to connect the Optical Line Terminal (OLT) at the service provider side with multiple Optical Network Units (ONUs) or Optical Network Terminals (ONTs) at user premises . It has one uplink optical interface and multiple downlink optical interfaces. The uplink interface connects to the OLT, while the downlink interfaces connect to the ONUs.

Downlink Function

The downlink refers to data transmission from the OLT to the ONUs. In this direction:

- The OLT sends optical signals to the splitter.
- The splitter broadcasts the downstream signal to all connected ONUs .
- Each ONU receives the signal but only processes the data intended for it, filtering out other traffic.
- Downlink transmission typically uses Time Division Multiplexing (TDM) to manage multiple users on the same fiber .
- Wavelengths for downstream signals are usually 1490 nm or 1577 nm, with a separate wavelength (1550 nm) for CATV services .
