

What cable should be used for the optical port of a gigabit switch



Overview

With a copper SFP module (RJ45 SFP), the port supports standard Ethernet cables like Cat5e, Cat6, or Cat7, making it suitable for short-distance connections. This is often used for direct links to nearby devices or between switches within the same rack. An SFP port on a Gigabit switch is a modular interface that accepts Small Form-Factor Pluggable (SFP) transceiver modules. They also offer flexibility in cabling options, as you can. Enterprise LANs use the RJ45 port on 100/1000BASE switches.
