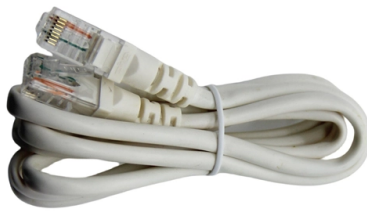


What does optical communication equipment refer to

Optical fibers guide light via total internal reflection, offering low attenuation, high bandwidth, and immunity to electromagnetic interference . **Receivers:** These convert optical signals back into electrical signals using photodetectors like photodiodes. They detect the incoming light and reconstruct the original data . **Amplifiers:** Optical amplifiers, such as erbium-doped fiber amplifiers (EDFAs), boost the strength of light signals to allow long-distance transmission without significant signal degradation .
