- **Splice Trays:** Organize and protect fiber splices, preventing signal loss and mechanical damage .
- **Fiber Storage:** Provides slack storage for excess fiber, with labeled areas for easy identification of fiber type and length .
- **Connectors and Adapters:** Facilitate quick and stable connections, supporting SC, LC, FC, or other fiber connector types .
