Safety Risks

Incorrect wiring can expose users to electric shock, especially if grounding is not properly established. Metal junction boxes must be bonded to the grounding system; failure to do so can allow fault currents to travel through the box or devices, creating a serious hazard . Misconnected neutrals from different circuits can also create unexpected current paths, posing risks to anyone servicing the system .

Operational Issues

Improper connections can result in flickering lights, inconsistent power supply, or malfunctioning devices. Overloaded circuits may not trip breakers immediately, masking potential hazards until a serious failure occurs . Additionally, incorrect wiring can interfere with electromagnetic compatibility, causing interference or “weird loops” in the electrical system .
