

What is the process of removing optical cables from an optical cable reel



Article Overview

Remove an optical cable from a reel by carefully unwinding it from the outside while avoiding twists, kinks, and excessive force on the connectors.

Step 1: Prepare the Cable and Reel

Place the reel on a stable surface or use a cable unwinder if available. If the reel is lying on its side, ensure it can rotate freely to prevent tangling. Avoid cutting the cable from the middle of the reel, as this can introduce twists and bends that may damage the fiber inside .

Step 2: Unwind the Cable

Pull the cable gently from the outside of the reel, keeping it straight and untwisted. If the reel is large or heavy, consider using a shaft or unroller to guide the cable smoothly. Avoid bending the cable sharply or applying excessive tensile force, as this can compromise the optical fiber's integrity .

Step 3: Handle the Connectors

When removing the cable from a device or protective packaging, grip the connector, not the cable itself. Pull the connector straight out without twisting. If the connector has clips or locks, gently squeeze the sides while pulling to release it . After removal, cover the connectors with protective caps to prevent dust accumulation and damage .
