

What level of distribution box is the plug-in box



Article Overview

A plug-in box operates at the tertiary (third-level) distribution stage, delivering power directly to individual loads.

Explanation

In a typical electrical distribution system, power flows through three levels:

- **Primary (first-level) distribution:** The outgoing line from the transformer to the main distribution cabinet. This level handles high-voltage three-phase power and generally does not supply power directly to equipment .
- **Secondary (second-level) distribution:** The distribution box in each building, which receives power from the primary cabinet. It contains large three-phase circuit breakers and distributes power to multiple tertiary boxes or units .
- **Tertiary (third-level) distribution:** The final distribution stage, which supplies mains electricity (220V) to individual devices or circuits. This level includes single-phase circuit breakers and is where electrical appliances are connected . A plug-in box is designed to connect directly to a busway system, acting as a modular distribution point for individual loads such as machines, lighting, or HVAC systems. It plugs into the busway and provides circuit protection for downstream equipment, making it part of the tertiary distribution level . Its modular, plug-and-play design allows it to be inserted or relocated at any busway tap-off point, providing flexibility and safety in power distribution.
