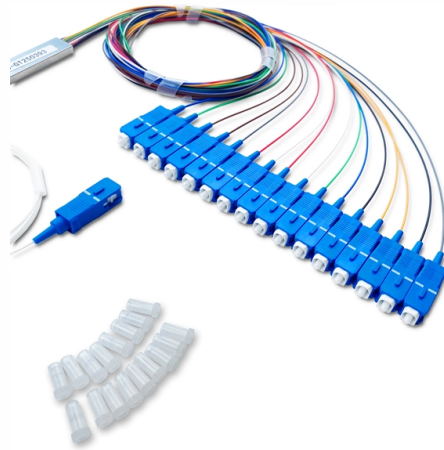


What level of distribution box is used in the prefabricated house
