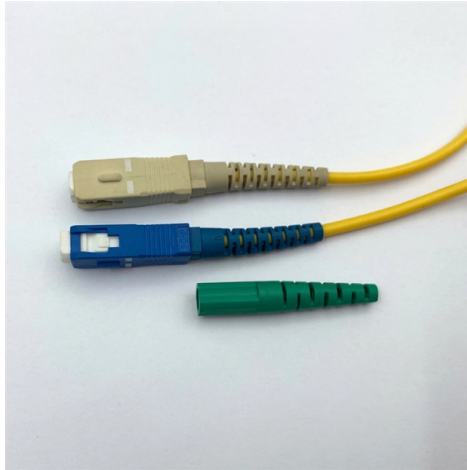


What materials determine the price of optical fiber cables

Core and Cladding Materials

The optical fiber core and cladding are made from ultra-pure silica (SiO_2), often doped with germanium to control the refractive index. This high-purity glass is the most critical material for data transmission and significantly affects cost, as producing defect-free glass requires precise chemical processing and energy-intensive manufacturing techniques .

Coatings and Protective Layers

Each fiber is coated with dual-layer UV-cured acrylate: a soft primary coating for flexibility and a hard secondary coating for mechanical protection. These coatings protect the fragile glass and contribute to the cable's durability, especially in outdoor or high-stress environments .

Strength Members

To maintain structural integrity, cables include strength members such as aramid yarn (Kevlar), fiberglass-reinforced plastic (FRP) rods, or steel wires. These materials prevent stretching and breakage during installation and operation, and armored cables with steel or FRP layers are more expensive due to the added material and manufacturing complexity .
