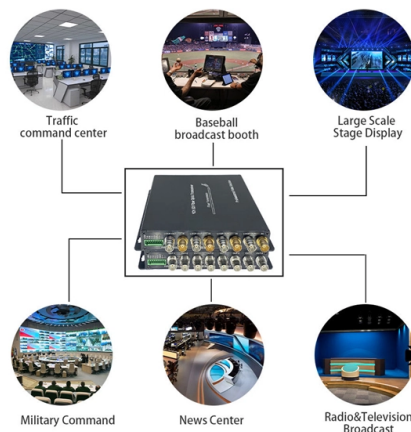


What quota should be used for fiber distribution boxes

A fiber distribution box should be provisioned with 20-30% additional port capacity beyond current needs to accommodate future expansion.

Recommended Quota

When selecting a fiber distribution box (FDB), the quota refers to the number of fiber ports or connections the box can support. FDBs are available in configurations ranging from 8 to 96 ports or more, depending on network size and deployment type (FTTH, FTTB, or PON) . To ensure long-term usability and avoid early replacement, it is recommended to reserve at least 20-30% extra capacity beyond the immediate requirement . This headroom allows for future subscriber growth, network upgrades, or additional services without disrupting existing connections.

Factors Influencing Quota

- **Network Topology:** Distribution-level boxes connecting feeder infrastructure to subscriber branches typically require higher port counts than subscriber-side boxes near end-user premises .
- **Splicing and Termination Needs:** Consider the number of incoming feeder fibers, splitter outputs, and splicing trays required for proper fiber management .
- **Environmental and Material Considerations:** Outdoor boxes may need larger enclosures to accommodate additional slack storage and environmental protection, while indoor boxes can be more compact .
