

What s a good height for outdoor fiber optic cables

Outdoor aerial fiber optic cables should be installed high enough to safely clear all obstacles, typically at least 18-20 feet above ground for public areas, with adjustments based on local regulations and span conditions.

Recommended Clearance

For aerial fiber optic cables, the height above ground must ensure safe clearance for vehicles, pedestrians, and other obstacles. Standard practice generally requires:

- Minimum clearance over roads and streets: 18-20 feet (5.5-6 meters) to accommodate vehicle traffic safely .
- Minimum clearance over sidewalks or pedestrian areas: 8-10 feet (2.5-3 meters) to prevent accidental contact .
- Clearance over private property or open fields: Can be lower, typically 12-15 feet (3.5-4.5 meters), depending on local codes and risk assessment .

Sag and Span Considerations

Cables are not perfectly taut; they sag under their own weight. Proper sag management is critical:

- Sag is generally limited to less than 2% of the span length, and tension should not exceed 30% of the cable's minimum breaking strength .
- For a 150-foot span, a sag of approximately 2.5 feet is typical to accommodate thermal expansion and contraction .
