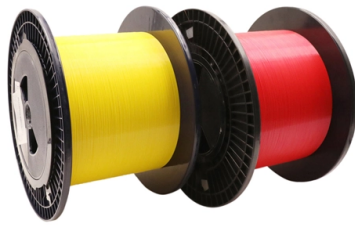


What should be noted when splicing fiber optic cables at the A and B ends

A bad cleave (chipped or angled end) causes high loss or splice failure. Inspect under microscope: flat, mirror-like surface = good. Open the splicer's windshields. Place each fiber in the V-groove, clamps facing up. This is where fiber optic cable splicing—the process of creating a permanent, high-performance join between two fiber ends—becomes critical. For network managers and technicians, a poor splice can lead to significant signal degradation, network downtime, and costly troubleshooting. Vendors are expected to continue applying general construction best practices and always comply with local laws and regulations.
